


We Misunderstood David

How I MIS-understood David




David did NOT BELIEVE in God!

1 The Lord is my light and the one who saves me. So why should I fear anyone? The Lord protects my life. So why should I be afraid?

2 Evil people may try to destroy my body. My enemies and those who hate me attack me, but they are overwhelmed and defeated.

3 If an army surrounds me, I will not fear. If war strikes, I will trust the Lord.

4 I ask only one thing from the Lord. This is what I want:
Let me live in the Lord's house all my life.
Let me see the Lord's beauty and look with my own eyes at his Temple.

⁵ During danger he will keep me safe in his shelter. He will hide me in his Holy Tent, or he will keep me safe on a high mountain.

6 My head is higher than my enemies around me. I will offer joyful sacrifices in his Holy Tent. I will sing and praise the Lord. ¹I lift up my eyes to the mountains— where does my help come from? ²My help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth.

³ He will not let your foot slip— he who watches over you will not slumber; ⁴ indeed, he who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep.

⁵ The LORD watches over you— the LORD is your shade at your right hand;
⁶ the sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon by night.

⁷ The LORD will keep you from all harm— he will watch over your life;
⁸ the LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.

- It seeks relationship




The wisdom of trust triumphing over clarity
