



- I am the true vine!



The Church, Jesus' Bride

Just as a Best Man is Happy when he sees the Groom He was happy witnessing the start of Jesus' Ministry

The bride belongs to the bridegroom. The friend who attends the bridegroom waits and listens for him, and is full of joy when he hears the bridegroom's voice. That joy is mine, and it is now complete.

John 3: 29

The one who comes from above is above all; the one who is from the earth belongs to the earth, and speaks as one from the earth. The one who comes from heaven is above all.

John 3: 31

But I am from earth

We declare God by accepting the testimony of Jesus
